This campaign consists of 3 bills for how New York can recover from the COVID-19 crisis and ensure that all New Yorkers are housed:

- 1. Emergency Housing Stability and Displacement Prevention Act**
 - Cancel rents and mortgages, while providing mom and pop landlords with the resources they need to stay whole.
- 2. Rent and Mortgage Cancellation Act of 2020**
 - Extend a true eviction moratorium for a full year after the COVID-19 crisis ends.
- 3. Housing Access Voucher Program**
 - House homeless New Yorkers, by providing urgent rent relief
