Expanding Food Access During Covid-19

City Harvest is New York's first and largest food rescue organization, helping to feed millions of New Yorkers who struggle to put meals on their tables. This year, we will rescue 109 million pounds of fresh, nutritious food and deliver it -- free of charge -- to more than 400 food pantries, soup kitchens, community partners and our own Mobile Markets across the five boroughs. We work alongside our community partners to boost community capacity, expand nutrition education, and strengthen local food systems. For more than 35 years, City Harvest has always been there to feed our city -- one day, one meal, one New Yorker at a time.

City Harvest operates 9 Mobile Markets & supplies 15 Community Partner Mobile Markets.
